

CMDA YEAR-END AWARDS PROGRAM RULES

- ❖ Rider must be a current CMDA member at the time scores are earned.
- ❖ All scores must be earned at shows listed in the current year's MDS Omnibus, and awarded by a judge with a rating of "L" or higher ("r" "R" "s")
- ❖ To qualify for year-end awards, one set (as described below) of scores earned must be from one CMDA schooling show. The other scores can come from any show listed in the current year MDS Omnibus for divisions listed below. The CMDA schooling shows for 2016 are;
May 7th at Safe Haven Farm, Durham
July 9th at Pittston Fair Grounds
August 6th at the Kur for a Cure at Snowfields, Pownal
October 9th at Esprit Equestrian, Durham
- To qualify at Intro thru Second level, a horse & rider combination is required to submit six (6) scores at three (3) shows from three (3) different judges. Two scores must be from a CMDA show.
- To qualify at Third and Fourth Levels, the horse & rider must submit three (3) scores earned at three (3) different shows from three (3) different judges. One score must be from a CMDA show.
- To qualify at FEI, the horse & rider must submit two (2) scores earned two (2) shows from two (2) different judges. One score must be from a CMDA show.
- To qualify at Western Dressage Levels, the horse & rider combination must submit three (3) scores earned at three (3) different shows from three (3) different judges. One score must be from a CMDA show. To award prizes fairly, we will split divisions if the awards committee finds it necessary.
- To qualify for Freestyles (including quadrilles), the horse & rider must submit three (3) scores earned at three (3) different shows from three (3) different judges. One score must be from a CMDA show.
- To qualify for the Riders Test, the rider may use different horses (more than one) to qualify, must submit three (3) scores earned at three (3) different shows from three (3) different judges. One score must be from a CMDA show.
- ❖ Horse and Rider combinations are eligible for awards at two (2) consecutive levels. Should a combination qualify for three, the lowest level's scores are forfeited.
- ❖ Year-end scores will be calculated by the level, and the two median scores averaged. A median score of 55% or higher is required to qualify for an award.
- ❖ To qualify for Grand Champion, or Reserve Grand Champion, one of the scores submitted must be from the highest test of the level ridden.
- ❖ Riders are required to submit a CMDA score report form, as well as a copy of the front of each test.
- ❖ Score submissions must be post marked on or before 15th of November of the current competition year for award consideration. (revised 2/15)
